

Springville Community Academy 2022-23 COVID Policy:

- The attendance plan for Springville Community Academy will be in-person. This would only change if we were advised to close school due to an outbreak of an illness that fits the DOE or Lawrence County Health Department definition of an outbreak.
- We will not contact trace or quarantine students if they are a close contact to a Covid positive individual.
- Masks will be **optional** at SCA building and at all events unless a student is returning after quarantine.
- If a student or staff member is positive for Covid they will isolate for **five days** and can return on day 6. The day that they receive a positive test is considered Day 0. They **must** wear a mask for days 6-10 when they are around others. This includes all extracurricular activities. If they do not wish to wear a mask days 6-10, they will be required to stay home for those days as well. If this is the case please notify the SCA office.
- A negative test or doctor's note **is not** required to return to school for positive cases that have quarantined the 5 days.
- We will follow our "Too Sick For School?" policy concerning illness. **Students should not come to school if they are feeling ill.** They should definitely not attend school if they have a fever (100.0 or higher), are vomiting, or have diarrhea. They should be fever free for 24 hours without the aid of medication to return to school.
- If your child tests positive for COVID and there are additional children living in the home, please calculate quarantine and isolation at <https://www.coronavirus.in.gov/quarantine-and-isolation-guidance-center/> for those children as well or call SCA and the medical office can help.
- If your student is in close contact with a positive case elsewhere, and you are considering a self-imposed quarantine, please contact the SCA office.
- If your student must isolate due to a positive COVID test, please contact their teacher to arrange the best plan to continue their education.
- This plan is subject to change due to changes in national, state, or local emergency health mandates and/or changes in the number of local COVID cases and/or quarantines.
